

Directions and arrival instructions for:

Newlands Barn, East Newlands, by Thornhill DG3 5EE.

DIRECTIONS:

A. From Dumfries, take the A76 Kilmarnock road to Thornhill. Drive through Thornhill and pass a blue sign on your left for Drumlanrig Castle. 0.3 miles from this sign pass a sign for 'Kilmarnock A76' straight on and 'Penpont' left.

Immediately after this, Langmyre farm is on the right. Take the small road on the right just after Langmyre Farm, marked by a white post with a red stripe. Follow route on section C.

B. From Glasgow, take the A76 to Carronbridge or from Edinburgh and Glasgow the A74M and A702 via Elvanfoot (signs to Drumlanrig and Thornhill) to Carronbridge on the A76. 0.6 miles south of Carronbridge on the A76 there is a sign straight on A76 to Dumfries and right to Penpont and Moniaive (B732(A702)) Take the small road on your left (sharp hook back) immediately after the first sign marked by a white post with a red stripe. Follow route in section C.

C. Take the turn from the A76, passing a very small loch on your left.

Go up the little hill bearing left at the Y junction just after the loch. The road tends slightly downhill beside a wood on the left.

At T-junction 0.7m from A76 turn left. A mile from A76 pass through woods.

At the junction 1.2 miles from A76 note a white cottage on left and drive straight on. 1.3 miles from A76 and just after passing a sign 'Railway Bridge 12.3m', before reaching the bridge you will see a sign for Newlands on your right.

Turn right up the farm road and Newlands Barn is about 100 yards straight ahead. **Warning:** Satnavs show the postcode as lying east of the railway line but the house is situated to the west of the Dumfries/Glasgow railway.

The cottage will be ready for you from 4pm on your arrival day and should be vacated by 10am on your date of departure and the key will be found in the keysafe which is round on the back wall of the kitchen beside the oil tank.

The code for the keysafe is 1805. In case of any difficulty obtaining access, please contact the caretaker, Mrs Hughes, on 07763 344176.

Please do not allow dogs on to the bedding and furniture, leave them unattended in the house or allow them to foul in the areas round the house. Failure to clear up fouling within the garden and courtyard areas will result in a charge of £30. While we want them to enjoy their holiday too, we would also ask that you ensure that they are kept under control, especially if there is stock on the land adjoining the house.

Services

Bed linen and towels are INCLUDED. Heating is by oil central heating and open fire (1 basket of logs INCLUDED). The first £40 of oil and electricity (combined) is INCLUDED with any additional usage payable by meter reading at the end of your stay. AGA usage INCLUDED. Wifi is available (subject to a fair usage policy). A maximum of 2 dogs are welcome at an additional charge (1 large, 2 medium or 2 small). If you wish to bring any other pets please contact us and we will see what we can do. No smoking.
